Isla Contoy

Getting there: Access is by sea out of Cancun, Puerto Juarez, Isla Mujeres, with a travel time of one to two hours.

- Home to approximately 150 species of birds, 250 different kinds of fish, 98 varieties of flora and three species of sea turtles in danger of extinction.
- Only allows 200 tourists a day on authorized vessels.



Isla Cozumel

Getting there: By air from Cancun, Mexico City and abroad, or via ferry from Playa del Carmen.

- Has the largest barrier reef in the Americas.
- Diving is the favorite activity.
- It has a large range of hotels, dining, shopping and golf courses.
- You can visit the Chankanaab water park.



Isla Holbox

Getting there: From Cancun, take the road to Chiquila (approx. 2 hours). Boats departures start at 5 am.

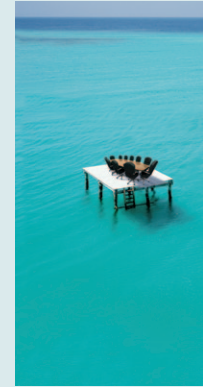
Golf
